

CONNECTING CORE ELEMENTS OF BANKING SUPERVISION WITH IFRS 9

PROPOSED DATES: June 30-July 4, 2025

TARGET GROUP | This workshop, aimed at mid-level banking supervisors provides a clear understanding of the core elements of banking supervision and their connection with the International Financial Reporting Standards-9 (IFRS9).

DESCRIPTION | Key areas explored include the Basel Core Principles for Banking supervision, as well as Basel guidelines on governance, credit risk, and Pillar 2 while exploring their interplay with the IFRS9 guidance and its implementation. The workshop aims to explore the core principles and discuss their rollout within the periphery of IFRS9 implementation through discussions, peer learning, and case studies. Participants will receive course materials and pre-readings in advance to enhance the engagement. The program encourages participants to share their country-specific experiences, foster practical peer exchange and collaborative learning. A pre-course study on several key elements of the course will also be required.

LANGUAGE | The workshop will be delivered in English language, with simultaneous interpretation to Russian.
