DESCRIPTION |

The three-day workshop on the Sustainable Development Goals – Financing Tool (SDG-FiT). It is designed to assist policymakers in formulating financing strategies for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) across five key sectors: health, education, roads, electricity, and water and sanitation. This workshop will provide participants with a hands-on opportunity to engage with the SDG-FiT, allowing them to become familiar with its core functionalities and learn how to interpret the results effectively. Participants will create a baseline scenario based on existing policy frameworks and assess the financing requirements necessary to meet the SDGs in the specified sectors. They will then explore various policy scenarios incorporating reforms aimed to bridge the identified financing gaps.

Participants actively contributed information on country practices and case studies, with peer learning serving as an additive element of the workshop.

OBJECTIVES |

By the end of the workshop, participants will be equipped to utilize SDG-FiT's interactive features for analyzing baseline and policy scenarios, enhancing their policymaking capabilities.
